Active Parenting: First 5 Years (ages 0-5) -

Support the growth and development of your children through family structure. Gain the skills necessary to prepare your child to survive and thrive as they grow up. 4-week program.

Active Parenting 4th Edition (ages 5-12) -

It's the full-time job that we don't get paid for: raising children. Help your child learn about and navigate society as you face new challenges together. 6-week program.

Active Parenting of Teens (ages 11-16) -

Increase communication without increasing conflict!

Develop skills that you can use every day, and help your teen avoid the risks of young adulthood. 6-week program.

Parenting Journey I -

A confidential and safe space to learn how your own childhood impacts how you parent, and set goals for what sort of parent you want to be in the future. Connect with other parents and caregivers on their own journey.

10-week program. **Starting November, meets virtually.**

Nurturing Fathers -

This program brings together men from all walks of life and family circumstances who want to become better fathers so they can help their children grow up secure, loved and self-confident. 13-week program.
