Safe Staff-Child Ratios

Infants (1:3) and (2:4-7)

Toddlers (1:4) and (2:5-9)

Preschool (1:10) full day center

(1:12) half day center

School-Age (1:13)

Mixed Age Group (1:3) and (2:4-9) [infants up to 2 years 9 mos.]

(1:5) and (2:6-9) [15 mos. to 7 years]

(1:10) and (2:11-20) [2 years 9 mos. to 7 years] (1:15) and (2:16-30) [4 years 9 mos. to 7 years]



Safe Staffing: Things to Consider

Staffing

- How many kids can staff safely supervise?
- Do staff/volunteers get background checks?
- What kind of training do staff/volunteers get?
- How are staff protecting themselves?
- What does active supervision look like?



Safe Spaces: What to look for

- Who can access the space?
- Is there a plan for emergencies?
- Is the space child-proofed?
 - Outlets should be covered
 - Cords and blinds should be up out of reach
 - Furniture that can tip should be secured
 - Tripping hazards should be taped down
 - Choking hazards should be out of reach
 - When possible, furniture should be appropriately sized



Making Shared Spaces Work

- The Backpack
 - First Aid Kit
 - Clipboard: Attendance/Emergency Contacts
 - Outlet Covers
 - Duct Tape
 - Cell Phone
 - Wipes/Tissues
 - Crayons, Coloring Books, Playdough, etc.
- Movable Items
 - Bean Bags and Rugs
 - Box, Bin, Milk Crate, or Cart of Supplies



Hygiene

- Bathroom Procedure
- Diapering
- Handwashing
- Food Service
- Cleaning and Disinfecting
- Illness
